UPDATES PENDING APPROVAL

ARTICLE VII: Members and Dues (Page 4 & 5)

***Section 5.** Each member of this Local PTA shall pay annual dues as determined by the organization. The amount of dues shall include the portion of two dollars and twenty-five cents (\$2.25) per member payable to Texas PTA, the portion of one dollar and seventy-five cents (\$1.75) per member payable to the National PTA and the Wyatt Local PTA portion of ten dollars (\$10.00). Teachers and staff of Wyatt Elementary shall pay \$2 local dues.

ARTICLE X: Meetings (Page 10)

***Section 1.**

- a. Regular meetings of the association shall be held in the months of September, November, December, February, March, and May, time and date to be established by executive board at its first meeting of the year. Five (5) days notice shall be given if change of date is needed.

B. Special Committees

4. Newcomer/Family Heritage shall:

- a. Be supervised by the second vice president;
- b. Be responsible for welcoming new students and their families and submitting new student recognitions to the executive board;
- c. Be responsible for coordinating, promoting, and participating in multi-cultural programs through the school in cooperation with the school principal/staff;
- d. Promote understanding of and respect for cultural diversity;
- e. Maintain detailed documentation of all job related duties, functions, and activities;
- f. Perform other such duties as assigned by the president or association.

15. Hardship/Citizenship Education Chairman shall:

- a. Be supervised by the 1st Vice President;
- b. Educated members in the proper protocol for the American Flag and pledge, as well as the Texas Flag and the pledge;
- c. Plan activities that educate and involve youth in citizenship activities;
- d. Perform other duties as assigned by the President or association;
- e. Maintain detailed documentation of all job related duties, functions, and activities.
- f. The Hardship Chairman will oversee a committee to provide organized, appropriate, non-financial support for families in crisis through recommendations from the school counselor or administration.
